

Maccabi services available without a Maccabi physician's referral

Tests Lab Routine

You may visit any Maccabi lab with a referral from a hospital oncologist. It is not required that you obtain a separate referral from a Maccabi physician, even for marker testing
 * For lab tests which a preliminary approvals is required, please see your physician.

Imaging Tests

You may visit any Maccabi labs with a referral from a hospital oncologist. A separate referral from a Maccabi physician is not required.

Diagnostic imaging tests (PET CT, MRI, CT and other imaging tests)

Diagnostic imaging tests require the approval of the national advisory center for imaging tests beforehand and to obtain a payment voucher for the test.

An oncologist's referral can be transferred directly and independently to the national imaging center for approval. No need to go to a Maccabi physician.

** A payment voucher for a CT test (not including cardiac CT, pediatric CT or CTA) can be obtained at the medical center. It is not required that patients with an active 1400 code obtain approval from the National Advisory Center.

Purchasing Medications

In the pharmacies listed below, you can purchase medications with a hospital prescription under the same terms. A prescription from a Maccabi physician or a signature of a Maccabi medical center are not required.

Prescriptions are valid for 14 days after issuance by a hospital physician.

*** At other private pharmacies not on the list who have an agreement with Maccabi, the hospital prescription must be stamped by a Maccabi medical center. Alternatively, you can ask your physician to convert it into a Maccabi prescription.

**** Medications provided as part of the hospital treatment will be supplied by the medical team.

Purchasing medications outside the health basket

Requests for special approval medications can be transferred **directly** to Maccabi – with a letter from the specialist recommending the treatment, including a detailed recommendation, medical documents and relevant test results – via the following methods:
